



INTRODUCTION



Welcome to the Drug Aware Torchlight Youth Film Festival!

This booklet contains everything you'll need to know about the program. Whether you're just starting out or consider yourself a pro, we'd love to see what you have to offer. The only restrictions on your film are that you have to fit the theme, be under 15 minutes and conform to a PG rating. Everything else it up to you! Show us your creativity and showcase your artistic flare.

There will also be a few skill building workshop days to look out for, as well as the final screening night!

This event is run by the City of Kalamunda Youth Services, and is only possible through the support and funding from the Drug Aware YCulture grant, Propel Youth Arts and Healthway.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

There will be two age categories: 14 and Under & 15 - 25

Films can be submitted from an individual or a group.

Either the individual or one member from the team MUST live, work or study within the City of Kalamunda.

THEME:

'EXPLORING CULTURE'

DEFINITION OF CULTURE:

The set of shared attitudes, values, goals, and practices that characterises an institution, organisation or social group.¹

For example: religion, hobbies (like sport and art), beliefs and even certain objects

JUDGING CRITERIA



- 1. The film must be 15 minutes or under (credits are to be included within this time limit)
- 2. The film must fit/follow the theme 'Exploring Culture'
- 3. Anyone who appears in the film that can be identified must complete a photo consent form (see forms attached to web page)
- 4. The applicant must submit a piece of writing explaining the story line of the film and how it fits the theme. Explanations cannot exceed 500 words
- 5. The film must adhere to a PG rating (see next page for more information)
- 6.One person working on the film must either live, work or study within the cities boundaries. Evidence of their status must be provided (see next page)
- 7. The film must include at least one Kalamunda landmark as stated on the list provided (see next page).
- 8. The film will be judged on its creativity. This will include how the story line is portrayed based on your written explanation, film construction, visual aesthetic how you incorporate the theme and landmarks. You will **not** be judged based on the quality of the equipment used (smartphone films are accepted)

JUDGING CRITERIA: CLARIFICATION



PG Rating Definition: (Parental guidance recommended)

- Mild impact
- Violence should be mild and infrequent, and be justified by context. Sexual violence is not permitted.
- Sexual activity should be minimal and if included, be mild, discreetly implied and be justified by context.
- Coarse language should be mild and infrequent, and be justified by context. No swearing.
- Sex, nudity, smoking, drug references and drug use are not permitted.
 *If you are unsure if your content is suitable, please seek clarification from City of Kalamunda Youth Services

Evidence of Status:

At least **one member** of your group **must** live, work or study in the City of Kalamunda. In your submission, you must include evidence of which relates to you:

LIVE: Address of residence and contact number

WORK: Business name, employer name and contact number STUDY: Letter from a teacher or principal confirming enrollment



Then, all of your amazing short films will make their way onto the big screen.





What needs to be in the final submission:

- 1. Title of the Film
- 2. Contact information for all group members
- 3. Explanation of the piece (500 word limit)
- 4. Name of the person who lives, works or studies within the City's boundaries and their evidence
- 5. Credit list of everyone who contributed/worked on the project
- 6. Photo consent forms for those acting or viewed within the short film (see form on web page)





HOW TO SUBMIT FINAL PRODUCT


Finished your film? Amazing! This is how to send it to us:

Upload your film to YouTube (can be listed as public or hidden so only we can see it) and email us the video URL.




