## Children's Services

## Joining your Local Library

**Membership to your local library is free.** As part of membership application you need to supply:

- *proof of your identity and current address* (eg. a Driver's Licence or Pension Card);
- *the name, address and phone number of an alternative contact person at a different address.*

**When you join the library you agree to accept the library's borrowing conditions.** If you are under 18 years, a parent or guardian will need to sign the register accepting responsibility for your membership and use of the library resources.

## New Stock

**New items are added to each library collection each week.** Titles can be found by searching our online catalogue and clicking on the 'New Items' icon. *Contact us if there's something you're after.*

## Borrowing Items

- **Members may borrow up to ten items at a time.** We have books in standard and large print, eBooks, audio and eAudio books, DVDs, music CDs, magazines and eMagazines, Kanopy video streaming, items in languages other than English, and resources for learning languages.
- **The loan period for items is three weeks.** Loan periods may be extended twice either by phone or in person, or once online, provided the item is not overdue or required by another reader. Loan periods for eBooks, eMagazines, eAudiobooks and Kanopy may differ.
- **Housebound Service** – A housebound delivery service is available for people who are physically unable to visit their local library.
- **To borrow items you must produce your library card at all times.** Please look after your card; it is your responsibility and a charge will be made for a replacement. You are responsible for any items borrowed on your card and you must ensure items are returned in good condition. Any damage or loss of items must be paid for.
