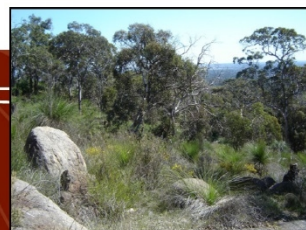

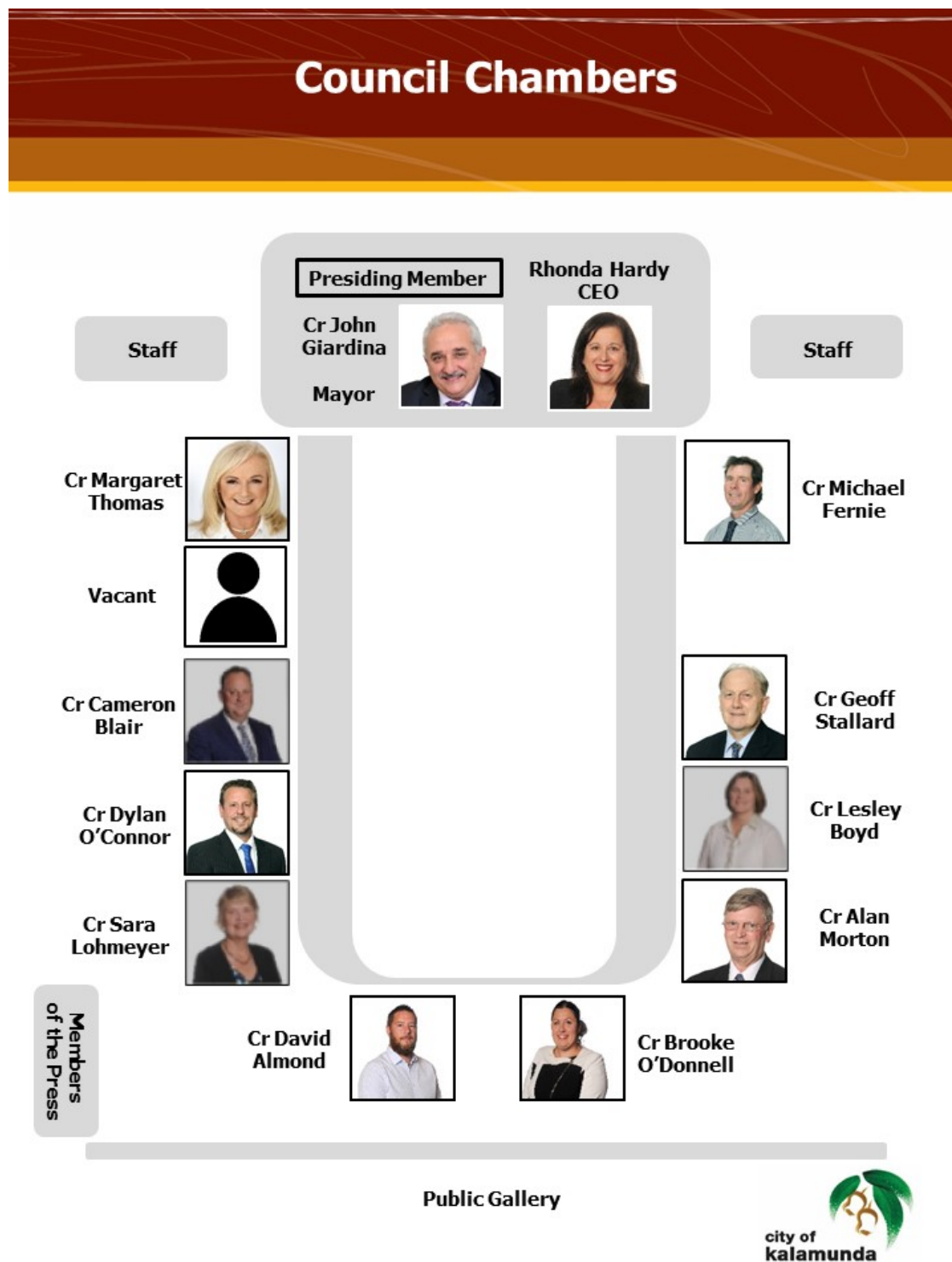


INFORMATION FOR THE PUBLIC ATTENDING COUNCIL MEETINGS

Special Electors Meeting – Procedures

1. Special Electors Meetings are open to the general public, however, only Electors may vote on a motion. Electors must register to vote in their capacity as ratepayers of the City either prior to the meeting, or otherwise, at a time that will be designated by the Presiding Member at the meeting's commencement.
2. The Presiding Member for a Special Elector's Meeting is the City Mayor, or if the Mayor is unable to preside over the meeting, the Deputy Mayor may be delegated this responsibility. If the Deputy Mayor is also unable to preside over the meeting, the Electors present at the meeting may choose a Councillor to preside and again, if the Councillor nominated is unable to preside, Electors may choose one of themselves to preside.
3. Members of the public who are unfamiliar with meeting procedures are invited to seek advice prior to the meeting from a City Staff Member.
4. To facilitate the smooth running of the meeting, silence is to be observed in the public gallery at all times except when asking questions.
5. All other arrangements are in general accordance with Council's Standing Orders, the Policies and decision of the City or Council.

4. Business of the Meeting

4.1 The purpose of the meeting is as listed in the Public Notice of the Special Elector's Meeting published on 13 November 2018, being:

- To consider the following motion in a Petition from Electors of the City of Kalamunda:

"The Electors here present call upon the Council to immediately cease all efforts to rezone up to 310 hectares of the area described as Wattle Grove South in the draft Industrial Development Strategy for industrial purposes in order to reflect the outcome of recent community consultation which shows that an overwhelming majority of residents want Council to reject this environmentally destructive land use option".

5. Closure
