- Building Services (BSL) Levy \$61.65 per application (0.137% if value > \$45000)
- **Construction Training Fund (CTF)** -The fee is calculated at 0.2% of the estimated value where the estimated value is greater than \$20,000

Asset Protection Fee: Administration fee - \$120.90 (non-refundable).

Site Plan (1 copy) at a minimum scale of 1:200

Plans depict but not limited to:

Lot boundaries; Site dimensions; Existing residence and any existing structures; Building set back dimensions from lot boundaries; Street name/s; North point; Position of any easements, (if applicable); Contours and finished floor levels; Vehicle crossover; Verge and street tree details; and Location of effluent disposal system e.g. septic tanks and leach drains if applicable.

Structural Engineer's Certification: (1 copy) at a scale of 1 :50 or 1:100 In the case of a partial demolition.

- Footings and floor slab/s;
- Footings to piers / posts;
- Retaining walls;
- Stair / Balustrade details;
- Strutting / perimeter beams; and
- Roof tie down;
- Columns;
- Reinforced brickwork;
- Unsupported walls >9m long;
- Any other structural components

Non – Sewered Areas

To decommission septic tanks and leach drains they must be pumped out, then they must be removed (after the Demolition Permit is issued).

NOTE: This document is a guide only to the information that is required to be submitted for most Demolition Permit Applications including those in non-sewered areas. Additional and specific information may be requested upon assessment of your application.
