# CATEGORY 2: ART SUBMISSION





### PHYSICAL ART- SUBMITTED DIGITAL

If your work is a physical piece, it must be submitted as a **jpeg (preferred) or PDF image,** saved at the highest resolution (300dpi).



#### DIGITAL ART

Digital art can be created using apps like Procreate, Adobe Illustrator, Photoshop, or Krita with dimensions Save as highest resolution.
