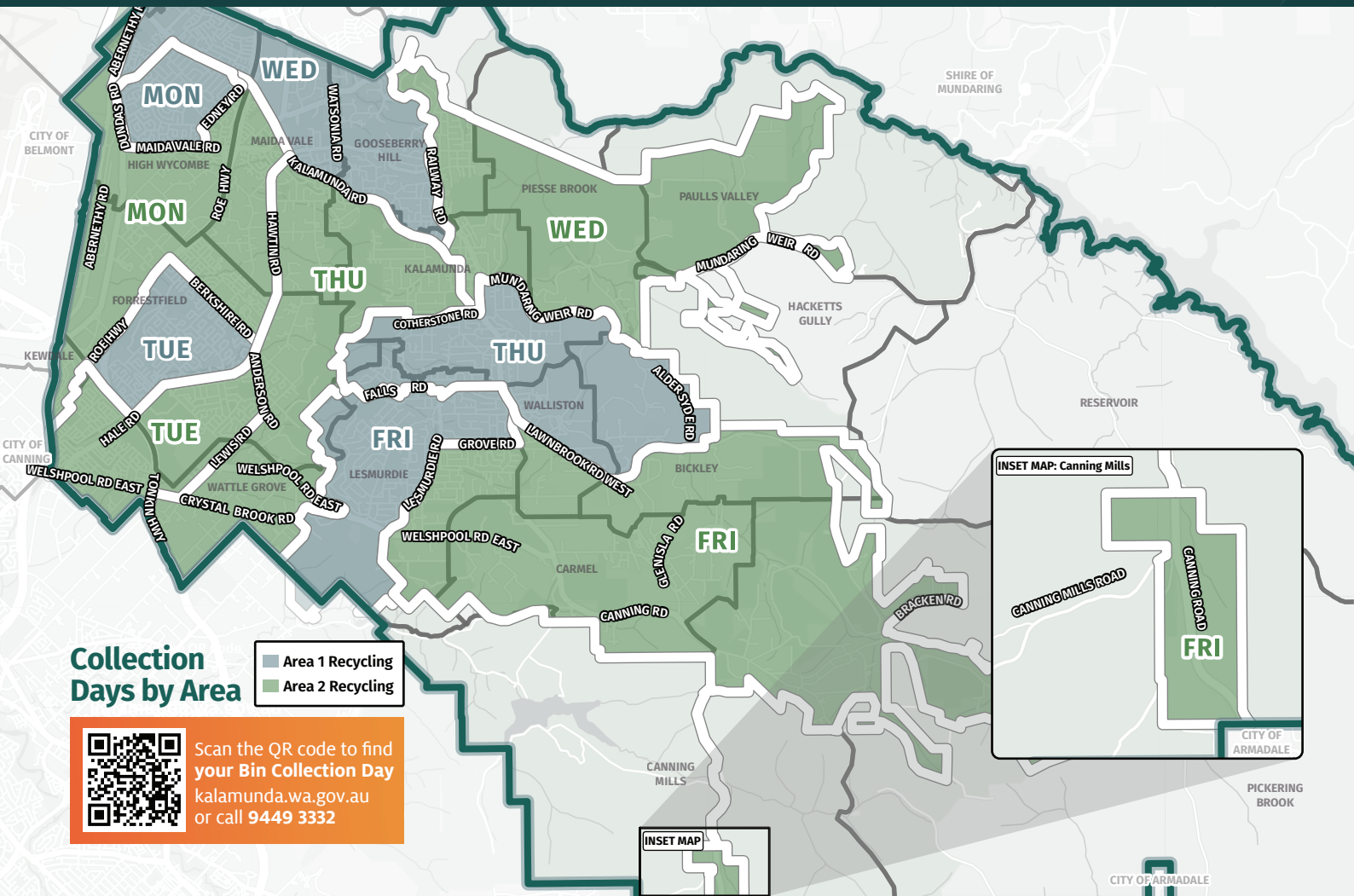

Kitchen caddy instructions

Your kitchen caddy is used to collect food scraps in the kitchen before you place them in your FOGO bin.



Caddy

Line your caddy with a compostable liner.
Or go nude with no liner at all.



Food scraps

Place all your food scraps in the caddy and other compostable material like coffee grounds.






FOGO bin

After 2-3 days, or once your caddy is full, tie up the liner and place it in your lime green lid FOGO bin.



Look out for the **Australian Standard Compostable symbols** (AS5810, AS4736) to ensure your liners contain no plastic.

Your caddy is dishwasher safe.
Just pop the lid off as colours may fade on the stamp.

-  **Only use certified compostable liners:** Certified compostable bags always have the Compostable AS4736 logo. These are made from natural materials, break down easily and can be composted.
-  **Biodegradable or degradable bags:** These break down into fragments of plastic and contaminate the compost.
-  **Plastic bags:** These don't break down and contaminate the compost.

You have been provided with a 150 pack of liners for this financial year.

General Waste

The **RED LID GENERAL WASTE BIN** is for your remaining household rubbish that cannot be composted or recycled. Your general waste bin will be collected **fortnightly**.

Allowed

- ✔ nappies and hygiene products
- ✔ meat trays
- ✔ polystyrene and foam packaging
- ✔ long life cartons (foil lined) e.g. long life milk, soy/plant milks
- ✔ and soup stock cartons
- ✔ unusable clothing and rags that cannot be donated
- ✔ plastic bags, bubble wrap and other soft plastics
- ✔ broken toys and small items (batteries removed)
- ✔ rapid antigen tests (RAT)
- ✔ face masks
- ✔ gloves

Not allowed

- ✘ food and garden organics
- ✘ batteries, electronics, paints or other hazardous waste
- ✘ clean recyclables

NOTE: Polystyrene can be dropped off at the Walliston Transfer Station where it will be recycled.

Recycling

The **YELLOW LID RECYCLING BIN** is for recycling cardboard, paper, glass, plastic bottles and containers, aluminium and steel cans. Your recycling bin will be collected **fortnightly**.

DO NOT BAG YOUR RECYCLABLES!

Rinse your empty containers and place them loosely in the bin!

Allowed

- ✓ paper (not shredded)
- ✓ cardboard (flattened)
- ✓ plastic containers and bottles (lids removed and put in recycling bin or drop off)
- ✓ glass bottles and jars (including broken glass)
- ✓ aluminium and steel cans (including lids, food cans and pet food tins)
- ✓ aluminium foil (clean and scrunched into tennis ball size)
- ✓ magazines, newspaper, paper envelopes, paper bags
- ✓ egg cartons

Not allowed

- ✗ aerosol cans
- ✗ meat trays
- ✗ soft plastics
- ✗ nappies
- ✗ polystyrene or foam
- ✗ long life cartons e.g. long life milk, soy/plant milks and stock cartons
- ✗ food and garden waste
- ✗ clothing or textiles
- ✗ bound or spiral books
- ✗ electronic waste or batteries
- ✗ spray or pump lids

Three easy recycling rules

1. LIDS OFF

Small plastics lids contaminate recycling.

2. RINSE

Remove contamination.

3. KEEP IT LOOSE

Loose items get recycled, items in bags do not.

Food Organics and Garden Organics (FOGO)

The **LIME-GREEN LID FOGO BIN** waste will be made into high quality compost, soil conditioner, and mulch, so there must be **NO** contamination. Please use only compostable liners in your kitchen caddy, never plastic bags. Your FOGO bin will be collected **weekly**.

8 | Mattress and whitegoods collection service

The City of Kalamunda offers a mattress and whitegoods collection service for a fee.

For more information or to organise a collection and make payment, please contact the City on **9257 9999**.

Residents will need to place items neatly on their verge. Please note: we are unable to collect from inside private property.

Bin Placement - *Placing your bin correctly*



Keep the weight of the bin under 70kg.



Place bin out by 6am of your collection day.



Ensure your bin lid can close and do not overflow.



Ensure no vehicles are parked in front of the bins.



At least **1m** from cars & street signs



Place bins at least **0.5m** apart



At least **1m** from trees & not under tree canopy (where possible)



Please place two bins out for collection each week:

See your collection dates on pages 2 and 3.

To ensure our waste trucks are able to collect your bins, follow the above guidelines.



The skip bin service is an on-demand service.

Residents can select from either a general waste skip bin (blue) or green waste skip bin (green). Households are entitled to any combination of three skip bins per financial year (excludes commercial and industrial premises). Both the general and green waste skip bins are 3 cubic metres.

Households that meet the following criteria are entitled to additional green waste bin(s) only, to assist with bush fire management.

One additional green waste bin is available for properties 2000m² – 5000m².

Two additional green waste bins are available for properties over 5000m².

Ordering a Skip Bin

The City has an online booking system allowing residents to register details, book days in advance and view allocations.

Please note: Book early - there is a high demand for skip bins! Allocations do not carry over to the next financial year.

**An additional fee will be charged for contamination. See 'Removal of excess or non conforming waste from skip bin' within our fees and charges.*

Green Waste collected from the **Green Skip Bins** is mulched & re-used, reducing the amount of waste sent to landfill.
Please keep green waste free of contamination.

- ✗ no asbestos

Please remember:

- Skip bins cannot be placed within private property.
- Skip bins must remain where they are placed.
- Keep the area clear so the Cleanaway driver can safely remove the skip bin.
- Skip bins will be emptied by 6pm at the latest the same day.
- If a skip bin needs to be emptied by the City of Kalamunda due to misuse, the resident will be responsible for all costs incurred.
- Day of use is the day following delivery, book gardeners or help accordingly.

- Allocations have to be used by 30 June each year. i.e. delivered on site by 30 June.

13 | Household hazardous waste (HHW) disposal

There are a number of HHW items which must not be placed in your bins. These HHW items can be taken to any permanent HHW facility such as those listed in the WALGA HHW program brochure. Please refer to the table below for the HHW item(s) that can be disposed of.

Note: The Walliston Transfer Station does not accept paint.

The EP allows unlimited access for the following waste types:

- ✔ Bottle top lids (plastic)
- ✔ Cardboard
- ✔ Coffee pods
- ✔ Dry cell and lead acid batteries
- ✔ Electronic waste
- ✔ Fluorescent tubes
- ✔ All metal types (cut to 1.5m length, height & not solid)
- ✔ Glass bottles
- ✔ Globes
- ✔ Green waste
- ✔ Motor oil (max 20L per entry)
- ✔ Polystyrene

No Entry Pass, NO ENTRY

The Entry Pass (EP) allows four free entries per year for the following wastes/combination of wastes:

- ✔ Building rubble
- ✔ General waste
- ✔ Glass (excluding bottles)
- ✔ Mattresses
- ✔ Timber
- ✔ White goods

Ratepayers/Residents do not pay fees for non-commercial use of the Walliston Transfer Station. To gain free access, you will need to bring your **Entry Pass (EP)** along with Proof of Residency (i.e. Driver's Licence). Tenants are advised to contact their real estate agents or property owners to obtain their **EP**. Please note your driver's licence must match your address.

The following items are NOT accepted:

- ✘ Asbestos or hardiflex
- ✘ Car bodies
- ✘ Chemicals
- ✘ Fire extinguishers
- ✘ Flares / explosives
- ✘ Food waste
- ✘ Gas cylinders
- ✘ Hazardous waste
- ✘ Putrescible waste
- ✘ X-Rays
- ✘ Liquids
- ✘ Medical waste
- ✘ Paints
- ✘ Rocks eg coffee/granite/ asphalt
- ✘ Sand or soil
- ✘ Smoke detectors
- ✘ Tree stumps (greater than 30cm)

Commercial fees* are applicable in any of the following situations:

- Commercial/trade waste

! For residents wanting to dispose of general waste, green waste or recycling at the Walliston Transfer Station with branded/commercial vehicles and/or trucks up to 3.5t GVM, a permit is required. Please visit the City's website for a permit application form. It will take 7-10 business days for the permit to be processed. A vehicle permit is required for oversized trailers (maximum 12ft by 6ft) to dispose of green waste only. No horse floats or car towing trailers permitted. No trucks over 3.5t. No trailers over 12ft.
