Our Purpose

As a YAK Member your role is to act as a **voice for the young people** and represent the concerns and interests of all young people in the City of Kalamunda. YAK is the **key youth volunteer group** for the City of Kalamunda Youth Services Team and will be frequently called upon to **support a variety of community events and initiatives run by the City of Kalamunda**. Advising on youth issues the group act as the **voice** to provide their thoughts and views on items to be put to Council that will affect the City of Kalamunda's youth.



What does being a YAK Member look like?

Membership is open to any young person aged between **11-25 who lives, works, studies or volunteers in the City of Kalamunda**. YAK Members are required to attend **scheduled meetings** and are able to contribute to those meetings however they feel comfortable. YAK Members will also be called upon to help facilitate a **variety of Youth Service's events** throughout the year including **week-long Youth Week Celebrations, end of year School's Out Celebration as well as other events created by the YAK team at meetings**.

Meeting Times and Locations

The meetings take place:

• Fortnightly on Wednesdays at Kalamunda Senior High School, 12 Cotherstone Rd, Kalamunda WA 6076 (Kalamunda)

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• Fourth Wednesday of each month at Darling Range Sports College, 117 Berkshire Rd Forrestfield WA 6058 (Forrestfield).

The YAK meets for an **hour and a half after school during the school term.** Each meeting we will learn a new skill that is relevant to project planning, ranging from budgeting skill, to how to design flyers and promotional materials. The YAK team will work towards developing and facilitating some awesome events of their own choosing, as well as assisting to run the various Youth Services Events!
